How much Tax Credits can I get?

Depending on the company's profitability the credit is paid as follows:

- Profit making company:** For every £1 spent on qualifying expenses, HMRC give a credit of 24.7p
- Loss making company:** For every £1 spent on qualifying expenses, HMRC give a credit of 33.3p

In other words, you can get back either **25% or 33%** of that expense back from HMRC. You can use our R&D tax credits calculator (www.taxqube.co.uk) to get an estimate of R&D Tax Credits.

Bond Street Station, London

The Hexagonal ceiling system is modern and bespoke that fits in well with the overall appearance of one of the busiest tube stations in London.

Berkeley Square, Mayfair London

Brimstone Missile Launcher

Air-to-Ground missile rail launcher weapons systems technology provides fast jets, helicopters and UAV's with the ability to safely carry and release air to ground missiles.

Each launch system incorporates three rails, i.e. one system carries three missiles. This allows a single aircraft to carry large numbers of missiles.



High Holborn, London

The location of the building is only 150m from the High Holborn station and it is surrounded by culture and green spaces.

Modern and open plan offices are offered by the building as a result of upgrading the building by carrying out extensive works.



Herne Hill Velodrome

Herne Hill Velodrome is the last remaining functioning venue from the 1948 London Olympic Games and has played host to world famous and Britain's most successful professionals such as Tom Simpson, Reg Harris, Fausto Coppi and Alberto Contador.

It helped nourish the young careers of Bradley Wiggins and Laura Kenny, two of Britain's most decorated athletes. The purpose of this design and build project was to create a new build pavilion and grandstand to save the venue from obscurity and sustain its legacy.
